Seventy-five years after the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor visit the Tama County Historical Society and discover the Tama County connections to this major event in world history. William Parks from Tama was assigned to the U.S.S. Oklahoma which capsized within minutes of the attack that fateful morning. His personal effects, salvaged from the wreckage of the battleship in 1943, are part of the museum's permanent collection. See other items connected to Tama County's military history, including stories about local veterans serving in the Pacific when the Japanese attacked.
